
Bookmobile

The bookmobile is a traveling branch library. Our bookmobile travels to the rural areas of our county. In 2017, the bookmobile had nearly 10,000 visits. The bookmobile circulates books, magazines, and audio books. Did you know... the bookmobile has been in service nearly 70 years!

Outreach Services

Our Outreach Coordinator services individuals and groups the bookmobile does not access. For example, we have patrons at The Jordan Center and the Louisa Senior Citizens Center. In 2018 we began our Homebound Program to reach patrons who have an ongoing physical condition that prevents them from leaving their residence to visit the library.

SUMMER FEED PROGRAM

- The LCPL Summer Feed Program provides meals to children ages 18 and under during the summer months, when there is no access to school lunch.
- In summer 2017, in conjunction with the Father Beiting Appalachian Mission Center, the library served 2,425 meals across Lawrence County.
- Meals were distributed in Louisa, Blaine, Fallsburg, and along bookmobile routes.
- In 2018, the LCPL became the only public library in the state of Kentucky to sponsor a Summer Feed Program, with no partnering organization.
- Meals will be distributed throughout May, June, & July from the main library with plans to expand in the future.

Fortunately, in the past the library did not need those funds for an emergency.


We are currently in the process of planning a renovation project that will allow the library to continue its growth and provide even more services to our community.
