Just a little bit farther than you.

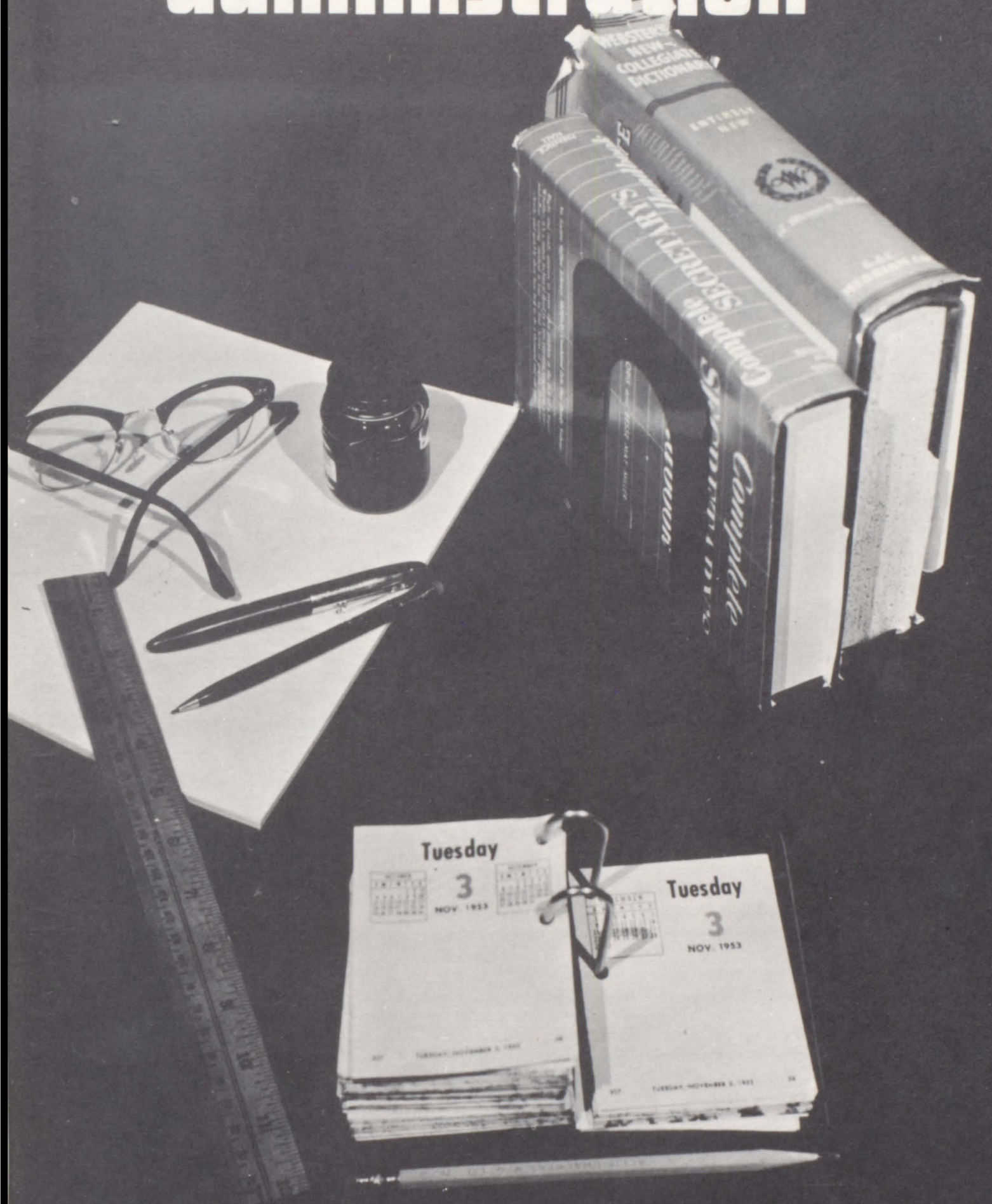
Don't stop here and stand at the bend of the road,

The place you are standing in now.

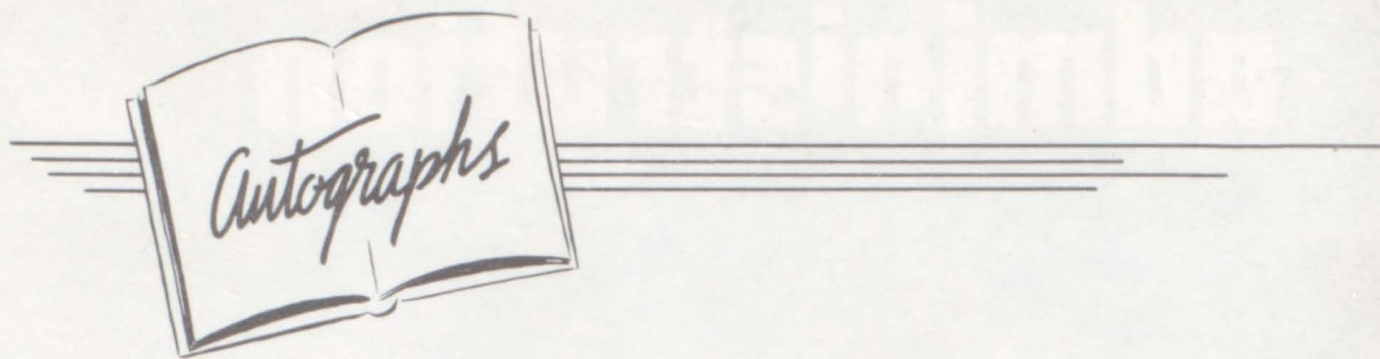
So keep right on climbing a step at a time,

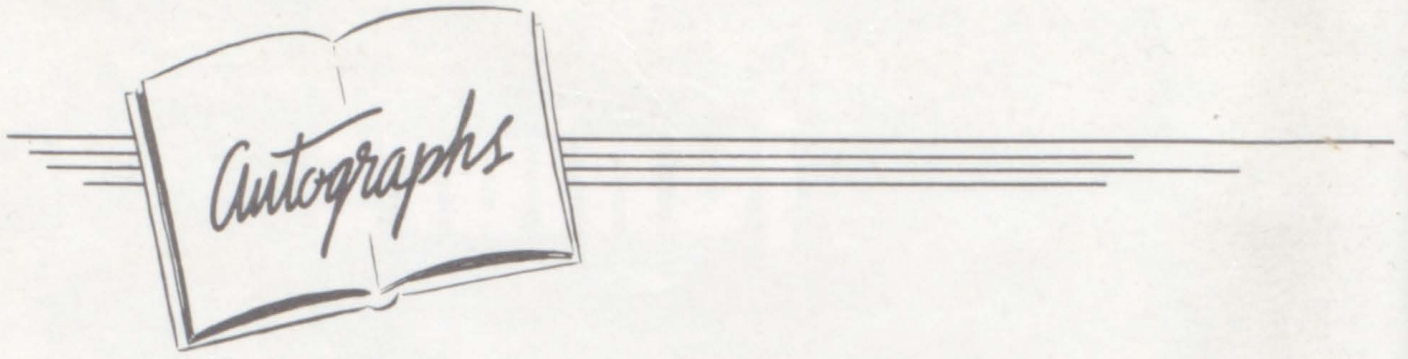


Prophecy
