

Helen Damron's Peanut Butter Balls

1 box xxxx sugar

2 sticks whipped margarine

12 oz jar peanut butter

Cream sugar and butter together, add peanut butter. Make in balls.
Let set to dry a few min.

Dip

Put 12 oz morsels chocolate chips, ½ bar paraffin in pan.

Melt over hot water then dip 2 at a time, lift out with a fork.

Place on wax paper to cool.

(Add vanilla if desired)
